**COUNTY BOARD STANDING RULES
BURNETT COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

Rule 1. County Board Meetings

The Burnett County Board of Supervisors (County Board) believes it to be in the best interest of Burnett County to hold meetings on a regular basis to provide for the orderly transaction of business.

The County Board rescinds any and all previous resolutions establishing regular meeting dates.

(1) Meetings. They shall maintain the two regular meetings required by law, to wit: the April organizational meeting shall be held on the third Tuesday of each April pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes 59.11. The November meeting shall be held on the Tuesday following the second Monday in November pursuant to Section 59.11 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

The County Board may otherwise meet on the third Thursday of the month when so called by the Chairperson of the County Board and the County Administrator and the time is to be fixed by the Chairperson. The County Board shall also meet for special meetings when called pursuant to law.

The Burnett County Clerk is designated as the person to give official notice to the public of all meetings for Burnett County Government.

A majority of supervisors elected shall constitute a quorum. The County Board Chairperson shall have voting privileges the same as any other supervisor.

(2) Supervisor Roll Call. Whenever the County Board convenes or reconvenes, the Clerk shall make roll call of the supervisors. All roll call attendance records of each supervisor shall be recorded on the journal of the County Board. In order to be recorded present, any supervisor who is not present for roll call shall at the first opportune time make their presence known to the Clerk. A supervisor wishing to absent them self from any meeting while the meeting is in session shall first obtain consent from the County Board Chairperson who shall so notify the County Board.

(3) Order of Business. The regular order of business shall be as follows:

- (a) Roll call.
- (b) Approval of previous meeting minutes.
- (c) Public comments.
- (d) Approval of Agenda Order.
- (e) Reception of memorials, petitions, correspondence, etc.
- (f) Appearances.
- (g) Resolutions and ordinances may be offered, and/or removed from the table, and considered.
- (h) Reports of County Board Chairperson, Administrator, Committee Chairpersons and County Departments. (
- (i) A day set for the adoption of the budget, and no other business to be considered until after the final adoption of the budget.

Rule 2. Supervisor Speaking

- (1) Every supervisor previous to their speaking shall raise their hand and address themselves to the County Board Chairperson.
- (2) When two or more supervisors rise at once, the County Board Chairperson shall designate who is the first to speak.
- 3) A supervisor called to order shall immediately sit down, unless permitted to explain; and the County Board, if appealed to, shall decide the case by a majority vote.
- (4) Any person, not a supervisor, desirous of addressing the County Board on any subject, shall obtain permission from the County Board Chairperson subject to a time limit set by the County Board Chairperson.

Rule 3. Motions

- (1) No motion shall be debated or put to a vote unless the same is seconded; it shall be stated by the County Board Chairperson before debate and prior to vote. By restating the motion, the chair formally places the motion before the body and assures that everyone heard the same proposal and can thereby keep debate focused on the motion at hand. Such motion shall be reduced to writing if any supervisor desires it.
- (2) Up until the time that the chair restates the motion, the maker of the motion owns the motion and may change it or withdraw it without the consent of the body. Once the motion has been restated by the chair, it belongs to the group and any modifications to the motion, including withdrawal, must have the consent of the body. All motions, resolutions and amendments shall be entered at large upon the journal, unless withdrawn.
- (3) When a question is under debate, no motion shall be received but to adjourn for the previous question, to lay on the table, to postpone indefinitely, to postpone to a day certain, to refer, and amend, which several motions shall have precedence in the order in which they stand arranged.
- (4) The motion to adjourn shall always be in order; that and the motion to lay on the table shall be decided without debate by a majority vote.
- (5) If the question under debate contains several points, any supervisor may have it divided.

Rule 4. Resolutions and Ordinances

- (1) Resolutions and ordinances must be sponsored by a Standing Committee, County Board Chairperson or by one or more County Board Supervisors in order to be presented to the full County Board for consideration.
- (2) Resolutions, ordinances, petitions, memorials and other papers addressed to the County Board shall be presented by the County Board Chairperson to the County Clerk.

All resolutions, petitions and ordinances shall be in the hands of the County Clerk six (6) days prior to the next County Board meeting, and the County Clerk shall mail copies of such to the County Board Supervisors and also copies to the Corporation Counsel.

(4) Upon the passage of an ordinance, motion or resolution affecting any county department, county official, or any town, city or village, the County Clerk shall immediately thereafter transmit a copy of the same to the county department or county official affected, and for the local municipalities shall transmit a copy of the same to the Chairperson of the affected municipality.

(5) Financial resolutions to appropriate money or transfers from the General Fund shall be reported to the County Board by the Administration Committee and shall require a majority vote of the supervisors present to obtain passage.

(6) Transfers from the Contingency Fund by the Administration Committee in excess of \$5,000.00 per occurrence shall be reported to the full County Board.

Rule 5. Recording Motions and Seconds

In all cases where an order, resolution or motion shall be entered on the journal of the County Board, the sponsor, the name of the supervisor moving the same, and the name of the supervisor seconding shall be entered on the journal.

Rule 6. Voting

(1) All voting by the County Board shall be by voice vote except where the provision is for the election of an office when the vote shall be by ballot.

(2) A vote on any question shall be taken by the ayes and nays. Any supervisor may request a roll call vote.

(3) Every supervisor shall vote unless excused by the County Board Chairperson.

Rule 7. Reports to County Board

It shall be the duty of each County Official or Committee Chairperson to present their annual report, in person, to the County Board.

Rule 8. Suspension of Amendments of Rules

No rules of the County Board shall be suspended, altered or amended without the concurrence of a majority of the supervisors present.

Rule 9. Rules Omissions, Roberts Rules

In all matters of parliamentary practice not covered by these rules, Roberts Rules of Order shall govern the proceedings of this County Board.

Rule 10. Repeal of Conflicting Rules

All rules and regulations conflicting with the provisions of this Code of Rules are hereby rescinded.

Rule 11. Effective Date

This Code of Rules shall be in force and effect from and after its passage.

Rule 12. Committees

(1) All Committees shall be appointed by the County Board Chairperson in consultation with the County Administrator, subject to approval of the County Board.

(2) The County Board Chairperson may serve as Ex-Officio on all Committees.

(3) All payment vouchers for Committee and County Board meetings shall be submitted by each supervisor/member to the County Clerk. County Board Supervisors may also submit vouchers for other committee and board meetings, where they have been appointed by the County Board Chairperson to represent Burnett County, if not otherwise reimbursed, subject to Administration Committee approval.

(4) All Committee meeting days, place and subject matter shall be provided to the County Clerk.

(5) All purchases shall be budgeted or have prior approval of the Administration Committee. In conjunction with the Infrastructure Committee, central purchasing will coordinate county purchases in order to provide a competitive pricing strategy.

(6) All purchases or exchanges of property shall be reported in writing to the County Clerk and then reported to the Infrastructure Committee.

(7) The Infrastructure Committee has the authority to determine the process of sale for county property/assets, other than real estate, in compliance with Wisconsin Statutes.

(8) Upon termination of employment of an employee, the Department Manager and/or the Committee Chairperson shall notify the Administration/Human Resources Department.

(9) Any person desirous of addressing the Committee, on any subject, shall obtain permission of the Committee Chairperson and be subject to time limits established by the Committee Chairperson.

(10) The County Board Chairperson may serve as a substitute supervisor on any Committee and exercise voting rights to constitute a quorum and transact business at that meeting. If the County Board Chairperson is not available, the County Board Vice Chairperson may serve in that capacity. If both the Chairperson and Vice Chairperson are unavailable, the Second Vice Chairperson may serve in that capacity.

Rule 13. Vacancy on County Board

(1) Any supervisor resigning from the County Board must submit a letter of resignation to the Sheriff who shall notify the County Board Chairperson.

(2) Any vacancy on the County Board may be filled by appointment of the County Board Chairperson for the unexpired term, subject to approval of the County Board.

ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE

The Committee shall consist of seven (7) County Board Supervisors. The County Board Chairperson, Vice Chairperson and Second Vice Chairperson shall serve as members of the committee; the remaining four (4) members shall be appointed in accordance with Rule 12 (1). The Committee shall have oversight for the Departments of Administration/Human Resources, Corporation Counsel, County Clerk, County Treasurer, Information Technology and Register of Deeds. The Committee shall also have oversight for county finances, tax deeded properties, and all other county owned property not managed by another committee.

Administration/Human Resources

To consider and review all adjustments of salaries, fringe benefits, and per diems. To establish procedures for maintaining personnel records of all county officials and employees and advise the County Board of their actions.

Approve all hiring procedures of all departments.

Examine and investigate grievances and enforce necessary discipline.

Before any contracts or negotiations with union or non-union personnel are finalized, the agreements shall be presented to the County Board for their approval.

Oversee all County Insurance Programs other than Property and Liability Insurance.

Financial

Annually prepare a budget for the county in cooperation with the County Administrator. To oversee all financial matters of the county for the purpose of keeping expenditures within control and within the budget adopted by the County Board.

Invest county monies whenever it is in the best interest of the county.

Review claims against the county and shall have the authority of settlement and payment of up to \$5,000.00 per occurrence.

Information Technology

Oversee the county technology systems and programs utilized by county departments to allow and create efficiency and productivity with new technology, as well as ensuring appropriate safeguards are in place to secure and protect county data.

Tax Deeded Properties

Manage and sell tax deeded properties. The Corporation Counsel, County Clerk, County Surveyor, County Treasurer and Zoning Administrator shall serve as advisory members.

Establish the appraised value of all tax deeded properties to be sold at auction by the county, pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes.

Review any and all proposed exchanges of tax deeded land pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes and to make recommendations to the County Board before such changes are acted upon.

HEALTH AND COMMUNITY SERVICES COMMITTEE

The Committee shall consist of seven (7) County Board Supervisors and four (4) citizen members that include a medical doctor, a nurse, an individual who is or has been a recipient of benefits and a Veteran. Citizen members are appointed pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes. The Committee shall provide oversight for the Departments of Health and Human Services, and Veterans Service.

Health and Human Services

Enforce the Health and Human Services Statutes, rules and regulations. Act as the County Board of Health, and the Aging Commission, advised by an Aging Advisory Committee.

Develop policies and authorize direction and planning for the delivery of all human services that meet the physical, mental, social and economic needs of individuals and families.

Review coordinated plans and budgets, set priorities on program operations within the funding mechanisms provided by Federal, State, and County government.

Assess the health status of the citizens and recommend policies that will improve the health status and assure the needed services are provided.

Veterans Service

Review and approve all expenditures as provided in Wisconsin Statutes.

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE

The Committee shall consist of seven (7) County Board Supervisors. The Committee shall provide oversight for the Departments of Child Support, Clerk of Court, Circuit Court, District Attorney, Emergency Management, Law Enforcement and Medical Examiner.

Emergency Management

Review and approve the emergency management plans for the county, consistent with the State Plan of Emergency Management, as well as the integration of the Municipal Emergency Management Plans with the county plan.

Law Enforcement

Review and approve all claims and expenditures pertaining to the Sheriff's Department, Jail and Dispatch.

Medical Examiner

Review reports and ensures that records are well kept and maintained according to the Wisconsin Statutes.

LAND USE AND INFORMATION COMMITTEE

The Committee shall consist of seven (7) County Board Supervisors. The Committee shall have oversight for the Departments of County Surveyor/Land Information and Zoning/Land Use.

Perform and enforce all county planning and land use matters as provided in the Wisconsin Statutes, county ordinances and resolutions.

INFRASTRUCTURE COMMITTEE

The Committee shall consist of seven (7) County Board Supervisors. The Committee shall have oversight for the Departments of Airport, Highway and Maintenance. The Committee shall also have oversight for all county properties and capital assets.

Airport

Has jurisdiction over all airport matters.

Buildings and Grounds

Be responsible for maintenance, repair, construction and operations of all county property, or as otherwise provided by Wisconsin Statutes or determined by the County Board.

Ensure the county has adequate Property and Liability Insurance coverage. Review all claims and when necessary work with legal counsel for appropriate handling of such claims.

Highway

Perform all duties required by the Wisconsin Statutes and such other duties that may be assigned to it.

NATURAL RESOURCES COMMITTEE

The Committee shall consist of nine (9) members: seven (7) County Board Supervisors, one (1) representative from the Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Committee (ASCC) and one (1) representative from the Lake Shore Association (LSA). The ASCC and LSA members have voting rights limited to their issues. The Committee shall provide oversight for the Departments of Forestry and Parks, Land and Water Conservation, Tourism and University of Wisconsin - Extension.

Forestry and Parks

To manage all County Forest Lands as provided by Wisconsin Statutes, county resolutions and ordinances and prepare Comprehensive 15-Year Forest Management Plan.

Manage timber sales.

Cooperate with the Department of Natural Resources on the Conservation Aid Programs.

Maintain all parks and park facilities, including boat landings, and all trail maintenance and signage.

Land and Water Conservation

Establish goal for conservation of soil and water resources.

Develop and adopt standards and specifications for management practices to control erosion, sedimentation and non-point source water pollution.

Allocate and distribute Federal, State and/or local funds for conservation programs.

Make available machinery and equipment, fertilizer, seeds and seedlings and other material or equipment to assist in carrying out conservation operations on public and private lands, when appropriate.

Provide technical assistance to land owners for conservation measures.

Make and execute contracts for conservation programs.

Manage and maintain county dams according to state regulations.

Recreation

Shall create, promote and conduct recreational activities in the county which are conducive to the general health and welfare.

Tourism

Promote county tourism through recreational programs. Coordinate private and public joint efforts to effect tourism throughout the county.

University of Wisconsin – Agriculture and Extension**Education**

Perform duties as prescribed by Wisconsin Statutes and at the direction of the County Board.

SPECIAL COMMITTEES

Special Committees, when created by the County Board, shall be for a definite purpose or time and shall hold over until such duties have been completed and shall in all cases report a statement of facts and their opinion in a final report given to the County Board.
