Burnett County Public Health is confirming that one additional Burnett County residents have died of complications from coronavirus disease (COVID-19). To date, we have had a total of 34 Burnett County residents die as a result of complications from coronavirus disease. Please help us in expressing our deepest sympathies to the family. Our thoughts are with them.
