** North Central Burnett County, at 3:37 PM cdt local law enforcement reported the Radigan Flowage Dam west of Dairyland has failed causing flash flooding downstream on the Tamarack and St. Croix Rivers! Bridges, possible roads downstream of the dam have become flooded! Locations impacted include, Markville Road east of Markville and all areas near the St. Croix River.

** **Instructions** - Turn around, don't drown when encountering flooded roads. Most flood deaths occur in vehicles. Move to higher ground now. Act quickly to protect your life. A flash flood warning means that flooding is imminent or occurring. If you are in the warned area move to higher ground immediately. Residents living along streams and creeks should take immediate precautions to protect life and property.

In an emergency dial 911, for all non-emergency issues dial 211.

June 18, 2018 – 3:15 PM

Due to heavy storms with accumulative rains that blanketed the county and surrounding areas Saturday, June 16th and Sunday, June 17th the following road closures have been announced:

1. State Trunk Highway (STH) 35 at the St. Croix River bridge is closed.
2. Highway 77/48 over the St. Croix River west of Danbury it closed.
3. St. Croix Trail at the St. Croix River bridge is closed.
4. Perkins Trail between Big McGraw Road and St. Croix Trail is closed
5. North Markville Road is closed at the bridge approximately one mile west of STH 35.
6. Big Island Road is closed at the bridge over Hay Creek.
7. State Line Road is closed from the Burnett County Line to Stuart Road.
8. South Markville Road is closed from STH 35 to 1.5 miles west.

All Closures are in the Town of Blaine. It is not advised to travel in the Town of Blaine until further notice.

Do not move or go around road barricades. Flood waters are unpredictable and dangerous.

Dial 211 to report any home or flood damage, and other non-emergency medical assistance needs.

Highway T west of Cozy Corner.

Markville Road east of Markville.
